




Game (Changers) of the Century

Tom's relentless research and documentation tells how Michigan State's head football coach, **Duffy Daugherty**, began the process of the integration of Black athletes into college football in the late 1950's through 1970 and beyond. Duffy's effort and influence of his Michigan State's 'coaching tree' helped end unwritten quotas limiting Black athletes at universities throughout the nation to a half dozen or so. Duffy's efforts helped open the doors to desegregating southern college football.

We are seeking investors to help our team tell these stories for the very first time in history. Our seed money raise is open for your review.








Game (Changers) of the Century
